# What courses can I take?

- See Course and Program Guide 2026-2027 on the Kal website
- Each grade has a set of *core* and *elective* courses that you can request
- **Core** – classes that are mandatory in each grade
- **Elective** – courses that you choose to take in each grade
- As you move through grades 8-12, more of your courses become electives as you focus on a particular area of study

# Grade 12

**Mandatory courses (2) – must enrol in at least one course from the following learning areas:**

**1. English 12** – must choose ONE of the following

*English Studies 12 / English First Peoples 12 / AP Literature & AP Language & English 12 (Linear, 12 credits)*

**2. Career Education** – must choose ONE of the following in gr.11 or 12

*Career Life Connections 12 (in-class) / Career Life Connections 12 (OTT)*

**IMPORTANT: If you have not enrolled in an Indigenous-focused course in grade 10 or 11 (e.g., EFP 10, EFP 11, or Contemporary Indigenous Studies 12), you MUST enrol in either EFP 12 OR Contemporary Indigenous Studies 12 (social studies elective)**



# BC Certificate of Graduation (aka, Dogwood)

- Requires **80** credits in your grade 10-12 years
- Most courses = 4 credits
- Most students take 8 courses per year
- By the end of grade 12, most students will have **more than 80** credits towards their Dogwood

# How does course selection work?

- Research courses in the Course Planning Book BEFORE course selection day (**Tuesday March 3**)
- Note: not all courses in the Course Planning Book will run 😞 depends on enrolment



# How does course selection work?

- Before course selection day, log into MyBlueprint and create a Gr.12 Plan
  - Ensure you select an **English 12** course and CLC12 if you have yet to complete it in Gr.11
  - If you have yet to take **an Indigenous-focused course** that satisfies the Indigenous Graduation Requirement, you **MUST** enroll in English First Peoples 12 or Contemporary Indigenous Studies 12
  - Ensure you are planning to have **80 credits** or more by the end of Gr.12
  - Check that you have a **Fine Arts 10, 11 or 12** and/or **ADST 10,11 or 12**.
- On course selection day, refer to this plan when selecting your courses

- On course selection day, log in to MyED > My Info > Requests
- Read the instructions!
- Select each course (both primary and alternates)
- Ensure you have prioritized your alternates, with the most desirable being #1
  - If you plan to enroll in an online course or academy, you need to enroll in the in-school course first!
- Once you have selected all your courses, ask an admin or counsellor to review your selections to ensure they meet all requirements
- Click OK to save all your course requests
