### Schedule

Monday is DDAA and Tuesday is CCBB. These are the final classes of the year. Course Completion days (Wednesday & Thursday) are only for students who have tasks to complete as recommended by their teachers.

### Lockers, Locks and Textbooks

Locks must be removed from all lockers by June 26. Grade 8-11 students take their lock home and bring it back next year. If a student loses their lock, they will need to pay \$10 for the replacement lock. Grade 12 students who received a free school lock last year or this year must return the lock or they will be charged \$10. Grade 12 students who bought a school lock in previous years can return the lock and we will give them \$5. Please make sure that all textbooks and novels are returned by Tuesday. Any items left in lockers after June 26<sup>th</sup> will be removed and clothing will be donated.

To qualify for the Principal's List, a student must have a 90% average. To be considered, grade 10 students must take a minimum of 8 courses and grades 11 and 12 students must take at least 6 courses.

### Grade 12 – Transcripts

Grade 12 students are encouraged to visit the Student Transcripts Service (STS) to preauthorize release of their final transcript data to their chosen post-secondary institutions (PSIs) for admissions purposes. Current students may make up to 25 PSI selections free of charge, generally up to six months after completing their last course. They are also entitled to order one free printed transcript (by mail) after graduation, which can be sent to any address they choose.
