Grade 12 – Transcripts

By July 7, 2023, Grade 12 and adult students are encouraged to visit [the StudentTranscripts Service \(STS\)](https://studenttranscripts.service.sts.bc.ca/) to preauthorize release of their final transcript data to their chosen post-secondary institutions (PSIs) for admissions purposes. Current students may make up to 25 PSI selections free of charge, generally up to six months after completing their last course. They are also entitled to order one free printed transcript (by mail) after graduation, which can be sent to any address they choose. All other transcript orders in STS (including [PDF transcripts](#)) are \$10 each.
